Dear Mr. Power:

We are writing to give you notice that, on October 23, 2014, a mass layoff will begin at GTAT Corporation d/b/a GT Advanced Technologies located at 243 Daniel Webster Highway, Merrimack, NH 03054. This mass layoff is expected to be permanent.

All affected employees have been notified of their separation dates and that their separation from employment will be permanent. The affected employees are expected to be separated from employment on December 22, 2014. There will not be any bumping rights for the affected employees, that is, employees will not be able to displace more junior employees as a result of this mass layoff.

Job positions and number of individuals who will be affected by this mass layoff are as follows:

- Administrative - 3
- Management - 14
- Technical - 22
- Production Workers - 7
